Entitled Let's Sit and Talk, this large-scale, hand-carved sculpture spells out its namesake in following Arabic script discretely doubling as a highly orchestrated seating arrangement. As the viewer moves around the piece, hiding places and vantage points for furtive observation reveal themselves. The calligraphic nature of the Arabic alphabet serves as a symbolic as well as structural component of the piece.
